- All entries must be created after October 1, 2022.
- All entries must be on 11" x 17" paper with no mounting, mat, or frame.
  \*Anything larger or smaller than 11" x 17" will not be accepted.
- Entries can include two-dimensional paintings, drawings, collages, prints, mixed media, computer -generated art, and photography.
- All entries must be sprayed with a fixative to prevent smudging and streaking.
- All entries must included (on the back) the student's name, grade level, school building and art teacher's name.
- The IU9 Art Exhibit Waiver and Release form must also be returned with the artwork. Waiver can be found at www.iu9.org under the "Parents" tab.
- Each School will compile it's own team of judges to evaluate the pieces of art and recommend a winner.
- All decisions made by each school's judging team are final.
- Send on the winners artwork to the IU9.

The following criteria will be considered when judging the piece:

\*Originality — 34%

\*Creativity — 33%

\*Aesthetically Pleasing to the Eye - 33%

- All winning entries will be shipped to the IU either by hand-delivery or USPS.
- A copy of the winning entries will be displayed in the IU9 Art Exhibit, original artwork will be returned to student.

One winner per building should be sent to the IU9 by April 6, 2023 to the attention of Shelby Johnson
