Course Objectives:

Participants will be able to:

- Understand what research explains about the reading brain and the implications for instruction
- Identify the structured literacy components in classroom practice examples
- Synthesize course content to develop a personal plan for aligning practices to the science of reading

The course fulfills the four required components for Structured Literacy PD:

- Evidence-based intervention practices on structured literacy
- Explicit and systematic instruction in phonological and phonemic awareness
- The alphabetic principle, decoding and encoding, fluency, and vocabulary
- Reading comprehension and building content knowledge
